






The Thirty-Two Keys

The Thirty-Two Keys by David Chaim Smith is the third volume from the Lightning Flash of Alef series. It contains a group of symbolic images that provide an overview of the nonemanationist interpretation of the Kabbalah based on sources that span eight centuries. The images found in the book as well as the accompanying card deck support a set of contemplative exercises configured for a 288day period and serve as an introduction to the greater path of mysticism in all its forms.

A Wheel of Small Gods


In A Wheel of Small Gods, Brian Wilkins and Brennen Reece offer a guide to reintroducing ritual healing by engaging with the 36 decan spirits of the Egyptian zodiac. Created within the sacred timing over a three-year process, these poems and images are talismans intended to connect you to those spirits of health and restoration. Through their many names, their sacred symbols, and the lyrics they inspire, their message is clear: you can change your life.

Engraved on stones and worn as amulets since before the loss of the Great Library of Alexandria, these many-named gods promoted physical and spiritual health. This deck continues that tradition: each card is a talisman, providing images and fragments of poems for divination, protection, and healing. The double deck design allows you to go beyond seeking answers to offering magical intervention: place them on your altar, carry them in your pocket, or give them to friends in need.




The Watkins Book of English Folktales




Stage Ghosts and Haunted Theatres


Nazareth: The Pillars of Gladness

Its 19 keys were received and wrought through a combination of spirit communications, dream incubation, ritual cut-up, and judicious co-editing alongside tutelary shades and attendant spirits. This Angelical psalter offers prayers for opening and closing rituals of geomantic divination, as well as for clearing the potentially dangerous miasmas of "halted" shield charts, and presents calls for directly working with the spirits, virtues, and materia of each of the Sixteen Figures of **Renaissance European** geomancy.

The First Ghosts - Dr. Irving Finkel Thursday 3rd November, 17.30 (instore)

A world-renowned authority on cuneiform, the form of writing on clay tablets which dates back to 3400BC, Irving Finkel has embarked upon an ancient ghost hunt, scouring these tablets to unlock the secrets of the Sumerians, Babylonians and Assyrians to breathe new life into the first ghost stories ever written. In The First Ghosts, he uncovers an extraordinarily rich seam of ancient spirit wisdom which has remained hidden for nearly 4000 years, covering practical details of how to live with ghosts, how to get rid of them and bring them back, and how to avoid becoming one, as well as exploring more philosophical questions: what are ghosts, why does the idea of them remain so powerful despite the lack of concrete evidence, and what do they tell us about being human?



The Power of Mind - Khentrul Lodrö T'hayé Rinpoche Wednesday 23rd November, 17.30 (instore)

The Tibetan Nyingma Lama Khentrul Rinpoche studied at the renowned Larung Gar academy in Tibet with one of the most influential and greatest Dzogchen masters of modern times, Jigme Phuntsog Rinpoche. His other teachers include Katog Rinpoche, and Penor Rinpoche in the Palyul tradition. He was later invited to the USA by Chagdud Tulku, where he is now based. Although highly respected as a great scholaryogi, he chooses to focus on the importance of Lojong, or Mind Training teachings, as relevant practices for the turbulent and disturbing times of today's world. This is his first visit to the UK.
