




The Weiser Tarot






Damanhur



Toil and Trouble




The Power of Mind - Khentrul Lodrö T'hayé Rinpoche Wednesday 23rd November, 17.30 (instore)

His other teachers include Katog Rinpoche, and Penor Rinpoche in the Palyul tradition. He was later invited to the USA by Chagdud Tulku, where he is now based.
