

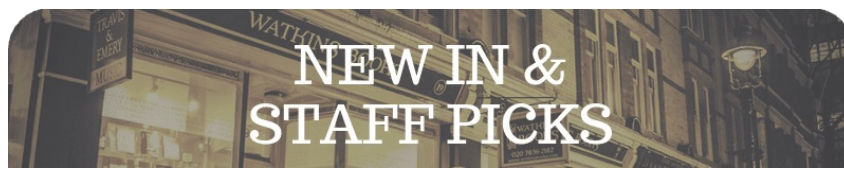
What's new at Watkins Books?

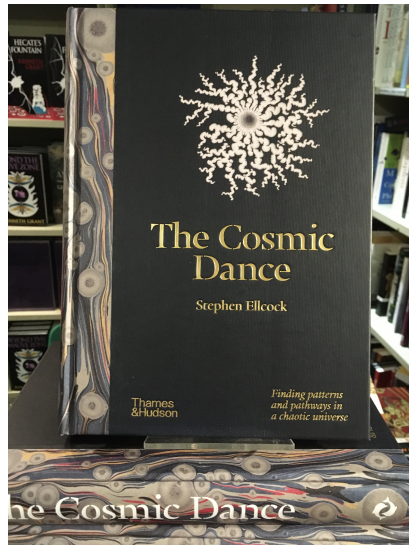

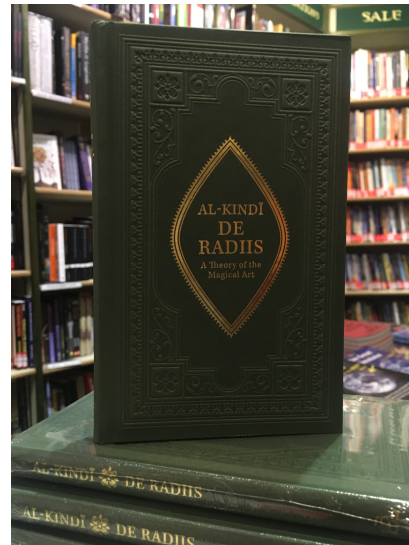

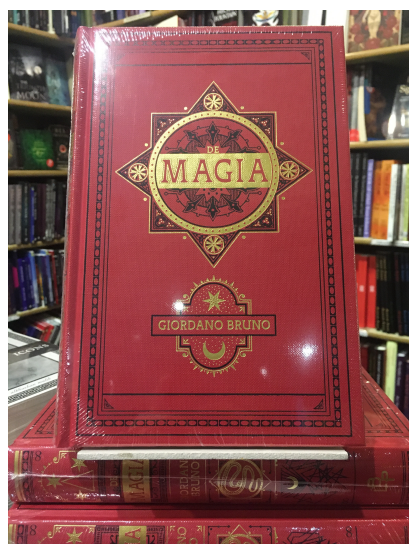

De Radiis

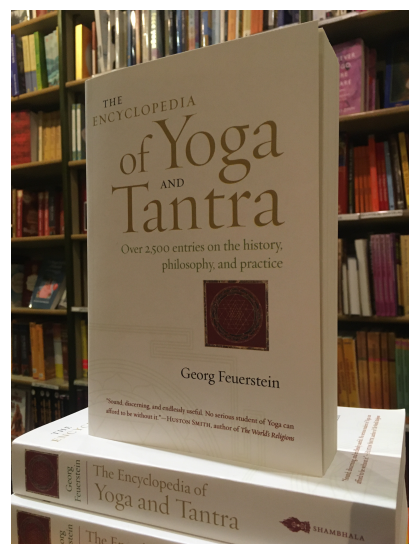

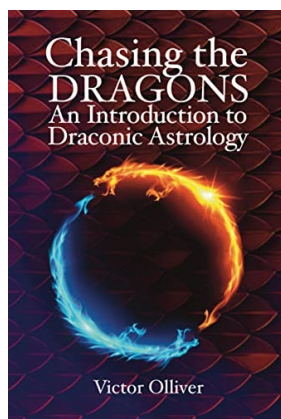
Occult Imperium

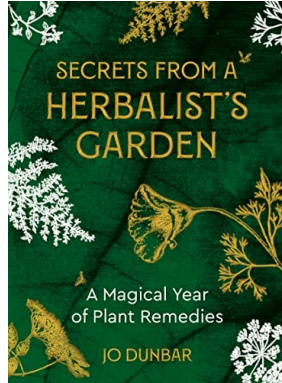


Chasing the Dragons - Victor Olliver Thursday 16th October, 17.30 (Online)

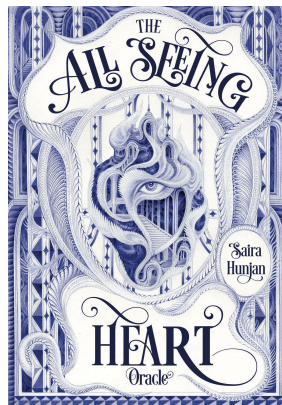


Secrets From A Herbalist's Garden - Jo Dunbar

Thursday 17th November, 17.30 (in-store)

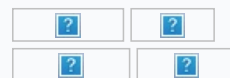
